**The A4076 Trunk Road (Merlin's
Bridge, Haverfordwest,
Pembrokeshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists &
Pedestrians) Order 2019**

Made 11 February 2019

Coming into force 15 February 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A4076 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A4076 Trunk Road (Merlin's Bridge, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 15 February 2019.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A4076 Haverfordwest to Milford Haven Trunk Road at Dredgeman Hill, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire that extends from its junction with Old Hakin Road (Glen View) to its junction with Avallenau Drive;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 15 February 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
