The Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal (Wales) Act 2018 (Commencement No. 5 and Transitional and Saving Provisions) Order 2021

## Duty to give a notice

- **9.**—(1) This article applies to a child who on 1 January 2022 has identified special educational needs and who is in a nursery class, year 1, year 3, year 5, year 7 or year 10.
- (2) Unless the new law applies in relation to the child, the governing body which provides the special educational provision to the child must either give an IDP notice or a No IDP notice to the child and the child's parent during the 2021-2022 school year [FI] or the 2022-2023 school year].
