**The Additional Learning Needs and Education  
Tribunal (Wales) Act 2018 (Commencement No. 6  
and Transitional and Saving Provisions) Order 2021**

**10.**—(1) This article applies to a child who on 1 September 2022 has identified special educational needs and who is in <sup>F1</sup>... year 10 during the school year 2022-2023.

(2) Unless the new law applies in relation to the child, the appropriate local authority must either give an IDP notice or a No IDP notice to the child and the child's parent during the 2022-2023 school year.
