#### GENERAL

#### 64 Restriction on right to prosecute.

[<sup>F1</sup>(1) Proceedings in respect of an offence created by a provision of, or regulations under, this Act may not be taken by any person other than—

- (a) a relevant health protection authority,
- (b) a body whose function it is to enforce the provision or regulation in question, or
- (c) a person who made (or whose predecessors made) the regulation in question.]
