## LOCAL GOVERNMENT, SCOTLAND

The General Grant (Increase) (Scotland) Order 1966

Made---8th December 1966Laid before the House of Commons15th December 1966Coming into Operation--21st December 1966

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2(2) of the Local Government and Miscellaneous Financial Provisions (Scotland) Act 1958(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, with the consent of the Treasury and after consultation with the associations of local authorities appearing to me to be concerned, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the General Grant (Increase) (Scotland) Order 1966 and shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is approved by a resolution of the Commons House of Parliament.

2. In the grant period of 2 years beginning 16th May 1965, the aggregate amount of the general grants payable to local authorities shall instead of being as specified in article 2 of the General Grant (Increase) (Scotland) Order 1965(b) be—

(a) for the year beginning on 16th May 1965, the sum of £83,185,000;

(b) for the year beginning on 16th May 1966, the sum of £93,130,000.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE (This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order increases the aggregate amount of the general grants payable under Part 1 of the Local Government and Miscellaneous Financial Provisions (Scotland) Act 1958, to county and town councils in Scotland for the years 1965-66 and 1966-67 from £82,070,000 to £83,185,000 and from £86,200,000 to £93,130,000 respectively.
