BETTING AND GAMING**The Pool Competitions (Licence Fees) Order 1971**

In pursuance of section 5(1)(a) and (c) and (2) of the Pool Competitions Act 1971(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Pool Competitions (Licence Fees) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1972.
2. There shall be payable to the Gaming Board for Great Britain—
 - (a) in respect of the grant of a licence under the Pool Competitions Act 1971 (otherwise than by way of renewal of such a licence), a fee of such amount, being not less than £100 nor more than £3,000, as the Board may determine;
 - (b) in respect of an application for the variation or withdrawal of terms or conditions attached to a licence under that Act, a fee of such amount, not exceeding £10, as the Board may determine;
 - (c) in respect of the variation or withdrawal of any term or condition attached to a licence under that Act being a variation or withdrawal in pursuance of an application in that behalf, a fee of such amount, not exceeding £100, as the Board may determine.
