The Secretary of State for the Environment makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

3. In this Order: ----

"the deposited plan"	means the plan numbered HA7/2-E83, marked "The London—Birmingham Trunk Road (Hardwick Estate Roundabout Approach, Banbury) Order 1974" signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of the Environment, St. Christ- opher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 OTE, where it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours;
"the new trunk road"	means the highway mentioned in Article 1 of this Order;

"the Trunk Road" means the London—Birmingham Trunk Road (A41).

4. This Order shall come into operation on 28th January 1975 and may be cited as the London—Birmingham Trunk Road (Hardwick Estate Roundabout Approach, Banbury) Order 1974.
