The Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1980

Made - - - 22nd December 1980

Laid before Parliament 7th January 1981

Coming into Operation 1st February 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 68(1) of the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1980(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1981.
- 2. For the purposes of Part V of the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 1980 there are hereby designated—
 - (a) the sports grounds specified in Parts I and II of Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) the classes of sporting events specified in Part I of Schedule 2 to this Order, at any of the sports grounds specified in Part I of Schedule 1;
 - (c) the class of sporting event specified in Part II of Schedule 2, at the sports ground specified in Part II of Schedule 1.
